Professor in the department of Clinical Psychology, University of Bergen, Norway and Member of the Correctional Services Accreditation Panel.

David, together with Karl Hanson and Ruth Mann, developed three of the most commonly used instruments for assessing the risk presented by sexual offenders. STATIC-99 (Hanson & Thornton, 2000) is the most widely used actuarial instrument in North America while Risk Matrix 2000 (Thornton et al, 2003) is now the instrument standardized on by prison, probation and police in England and Wales, and is widely used in other parts of the UK. The Structured Risk Assessment framework (Thornton, 2002) is now (under the name of Structured Assessment of Risk and Needs) the standard dynamic risk assessment used in conjunction with sexual offender treatment by Her Majesty's Prison Service.

David led a team which provided the central administration and support for a range of multi-site treatment programs. Programs developed through this initiative are now used throughout the UK, and in a range of other countries. In recent years he has focused on the management and treatment of high risk sexual and violent offenders.

Current collaborative projects he is working on include:

- ◆ Developing a new generation of risk assessment instruments
- ◆ Integrating an international collection of Static-99 recidivism data sets to produce new norms for this widely used instrument.
- ◆ Testing the long-term predictive value of modern risk assessment instruments when applied to old case files.
